## City of Ottawa Landlord Licensing Update

As of September 27, here is the status in respect to the City's consideration of landlord licensing/rental regulation.

Within days, the consultants' final recommendations should be released.

The following are key dates that will follow the release of the consultants' final report:

| October 4 to 18         | The online survey for the third and final round of consultations for the Rental Accommodations Study will be available.   |

| November 27             | City Council will decide the issue in principle.  |
| November 27<br>to March | The City staff will work up whatever bylaws changes are necessary to implement either enhanced by-law enforcement or landlord licensing.  |
