As of September 27, here is the status in respect to the City's consideration of landlord licensing/rental regulation.

Within days, the consultants' final recommendations should be released.

The following are key dates that will follow the release of the consultants' final report:

| October 4 to 18 | The online survey for the third and final round of consultations for the Rental Accommodations Study will be available. |
| October 22 and 23 | The City staff consultations will take place from 6:00-8:00pm. The October 22 consultation will take place at Ben Franklin Place, and the October 23 consultation will take place at Nepean Sportsplex. |
| November 4 | The City staff's recommendations will be issued in the staff report.

After the staff report is issued, EOLO will make its position known to the City, and will post an update here. |
| November 15 | The Community and Protective Services Committee will consider the staff recommendations.
The special meeting will take place at 9:30am at City Hall (in either the Champlain Room or the Council Chambers) |
| November 27 | City Council will decide the issue in principle. |
| November 27
to March | The City staff will work up whatever bylaws changes are necessary to implement either enhanced by-law enforcement or landlord licensing. |
